

#### **Executive Summary – SDG 8: Decent Work and Economic Growth (AY 2024–2025)**

Gulf University (GU) is committed to supporting Sustainable Development Goal 8 – Decent Work and Economic Growth – by fostering a culture of entrepreneurship, skills development, and sustainable employment. During AY 2024–2025, GU enhanced its partnerships with industries, offered training and workshops focused on employability, and created platforms for innovation and start-ups through the Sustainability and Development Makers Center (SDM-C) and the Community Engagement & Continuing Education Centre (CECEC).

## Key achievements include:

Implementation of employability and entrepreneurship training programs for students and graduates. Launch of the Green Start-Up Incubator under the GU Sustainable Engineering Hub. Organization of job fairs and professional development sessions.

Development of courses and research initiatives promoting inclusive and sustainable economic growth. Collaboration with national agencies and private sectors to align education with market needs.

Through these strategic efforts, GU supports Bahrain Vision 2030 by preparing graduates who contribute to sustainable economic diversification and inclusive growth.














