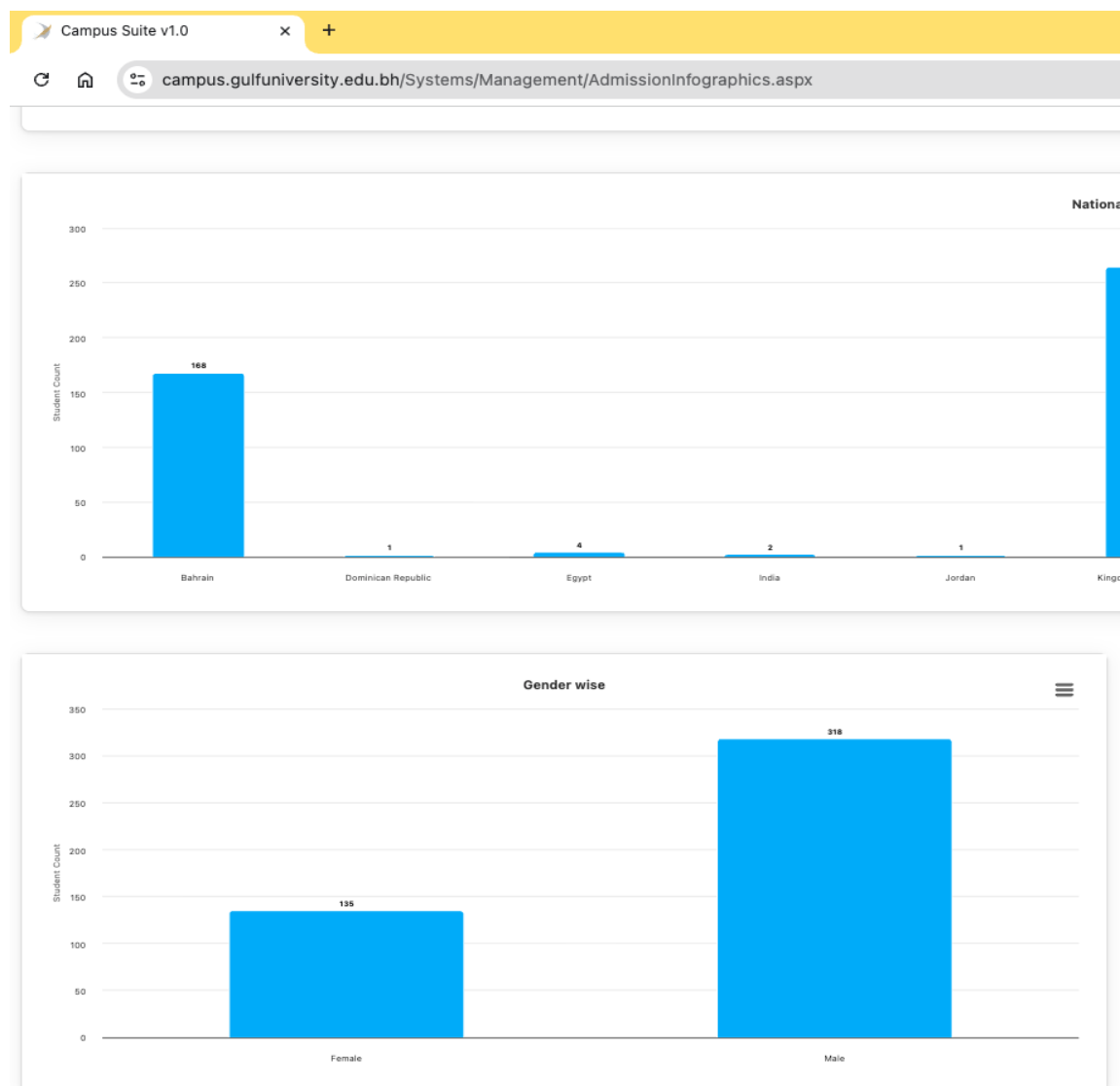
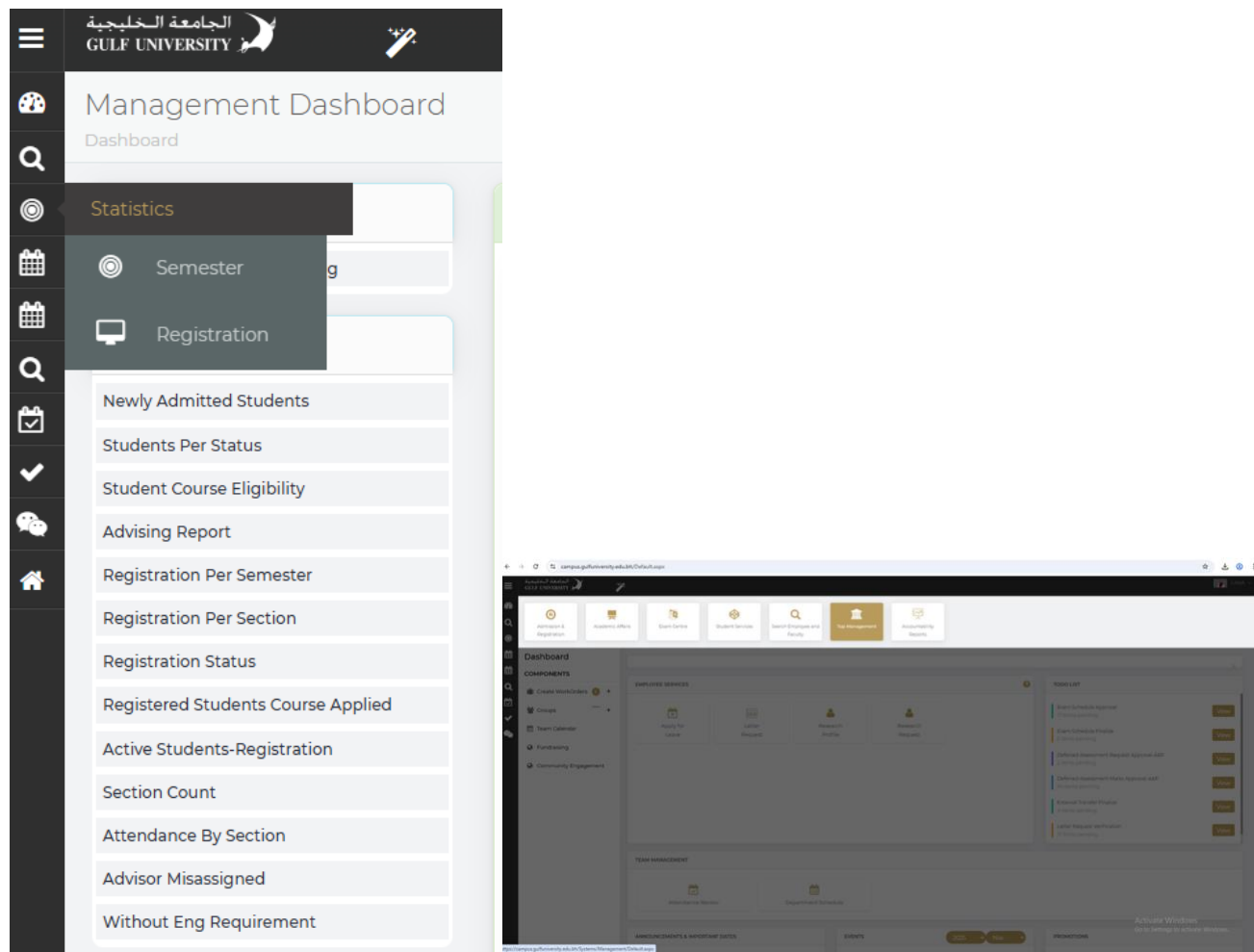


Students Access Measures (Jan – Dec 2024)

Introduction

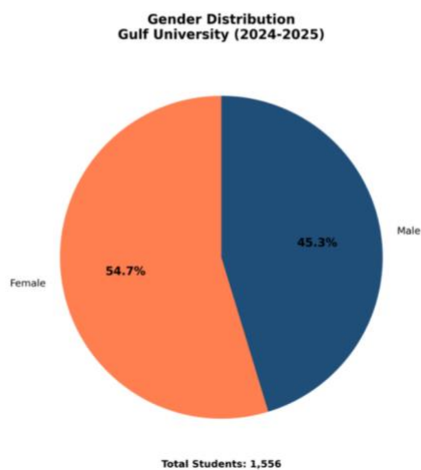
Gulf University systematically tracks women's application, acceptance, and entry rates through its Admission and Registration Information System (which is Campus Suite). Gender-disaggregated data are compiled annually by the Admission & Registration Department and reviewed by the Accreditation & Ranking Unit. In 2024–25, women represented 54.7 % of total students (851 of 1,556) and approximately 65 % of new entrants. This information is published within the SDG 10 and SDG 5 reports and displayed on the university's Dashboard.

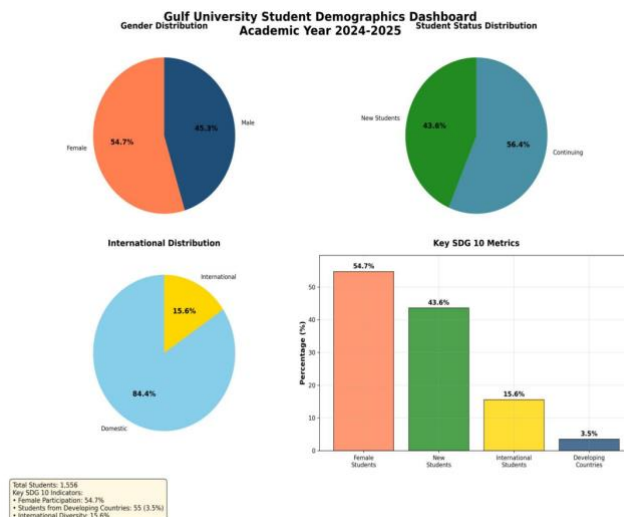




2. Student Status Distribution

The university maintains a balanced student population with 43.6% new students (679 students) and 56.4% continuing students (877 students). This distribution indicates healthy enrollment growth and retention rates.
